No medications will be administered at the Monroe Street Movement Space unless in the case of life-threatening circumstances. In this case of life threatening circumstances, the medication shall be administered only after receipt of written authorization from the student's parent/guardian. All medication shall be labeled and stored in the original prescription container and in accordance with manufacturers' instruction. The child's name must also be clearly labeled on the medication. Personally contact Movement Space Health Directors, before your first day of attendance, if this applies to your child so that the proper procedure can be implemented.
